Lieutenant Colonel Kingston Lampley is the operations officer for the 99th Air Refueling Squadron in Birmingham, AL. As an Active Associate operations officer, he provides leadership and direction for over 120 military men and women, from maintenance, support, and operations specialties supporting Air Mobility Command and the 117th Air Refueling Wing's mission of performing global air refueling and airlift in direct support of the Air Force's Global Reach, Global Power missions.

Lieutenant Colonel Lampley grew up in East Orange, NJ and was commissioned into the Air Force as a Distinguished Graduate of Auburn University's AFROTC program in June 1994. He is a Senior Pilot with over 3,800 hours flying the C-9, C-5, and KC-135 aircraft.
