Prior to attending the First Sergeant Academy in July 09, MSgt Tolliver served as the acting first sergeant for the 30<sup>th</sup> Medical Group from April 08-Feb 09 and then again for the 30<sup>th</sup> Comptroller Squadron/Wing Staff Agencies from Mar-Jun 09 at Vandenberg AFB, California

Prior to being selected as Acting 1<sup>st</sup> Sgt, MSgt Tolliver was Flight Chief for the Primary Treatment Flight, 30<sup>th</sup> Medical Operations Squadron, Vandenberg AFB. During that time she oversaw daily operations for primary care, physical therapy, pediatrics and immunizations as well as performing patient care as a physical therapy technician. She was responsible for administrative duties and the overall patient care of approximately 4000 assigned AD members and their dependants.

MSgt Tolliver was born May 25, 1970, in Newark, Ohio. She graduated from Utica High School in 1988 and entered into the Air Force in November of 1990. She completed technical training as a physical therapy technician at Sheppard AFB, Texas in April 1991, and was assigned as a physical therapy apprentice to the 15<sup>th</sup> Medical Group, Hickam AFB, HI.
