Lt Colonel Trey Bass commands the 117th Security Forces Squadron, 117th Air Refueling Wing, Alabama Air National Guard, located at Birmingham International Airport, Birmingham, Alabama. He is responsible for providing motivated, trained, and effective Security Forces to deploy in a force protection role in support of Air Force contingency operations, integrating with joint U.S. forces and / or host nation forces.

Responsibilities include control and direction of Security Forces personnel providing support for resource protection, managing security forces programs including installation security, air base defense, weapon systems security, law enforcement, training, resource protection, information security, personnel security, industrial security, and security classification management.

Lt Colonel Bass began his military career enlisting as an Aircraft Maintenance Technician July 19, 1985 with the 117th Tactical Reconnaissance Wing, Alabama Air National Guard in Birmingham, Alabama. In 1991 he was selected for the Air National Guard Specialized Undergraduate Navigator Training Program. He earned his commission as a second lieutenant through the Academy of Military Science in Tennessee on July 08th 1991. Over his career Lt Colonel Bass has gained experience in Aircraft maintenance, Operational Flight Time in the RF-4C, Operational Flight Time in the KC-135R and as a Security Forces Officer. He flew combat sorties as a KC-135R Navigator during Operation Northern Watch, Operation Southern Watch, and Bosnia. As a Security Forces Officer, Lt Colonel Bass forward deployed to Kandahar and Bagram, Afghanistan as a Liaison in support of Operation Fundamental Justice. August 2010 through February 2011 Lt Colonel Bass commanded the 376 Expeditionary Security Forces Squadron, Manas Transit Center, Kyrgyzstan Republic.
