Lieutenant Colonel Scott Grant is the 106th Air Refueling Squadron Commander, 117th Operations Group, 117th Air Refueling Wing, Alabama Air National Guard, Birmingham, Alabama.

Lieutenant Colonel Grant received his commission as a Second Lieutenant in the USAF through the Reserve Officer Training Corp in 1987 and graduated from Undergraduate Pilot training in March 1989 at Columbus AFB, MS. Lieutenant Colonel Grant was then assigned to the 41st Air Refueling Squadron and later the 509th Air Refueling Squadron at Griffiss, AFB, NY as a pilot flying the KC-135A/R. Lieutenant Colonel Grant was then assigned to the 917th Air Refueling Squadron Dyess AFB, TX, as an Aircraft Commander and Instructor in the KC-135A/Q. He was then assigned to the Defense Logistics Agency DPRO Pemco Aeroplex as a flight test pilot flying the KC-135 A/Q/E/R/T aircraft. Lieutenant Colonel Grant was then assigned to the 106th Air Refueling Squadron in 1996 flying the KC-135R.

Prior to his current position, Lieutenant Colonel Grant was Operations Officer, 106th Air Refueling Squadron, Alabama Air National Guard, Birmingham, AL.
